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## **OBJECTIVES**

Listening comprehension is one of the linguistic skills related to the interpretation of oral speech. Its main goal is to develop the student's capacity of understanding the context of the orally transmitted messages. The purpose of this course is that the ELE students better their ability in this area, by not only working the linguistic area, also with the cognitive, perceptive, attitude and sociological as well, necessary in oral speech.

In this course, the student will also develop the ability to analyze and distinguish the different sounds of the Spanish phonetic system and its varieties.

Although this course concentrates on the listening comprehension, the rest of the skills (oral expression, reading comprehension and written expression) are also included.

## **INSTRUCTIONAL FORMAT**

Since the listening comprehension must depart from real oral texts, besides the use of the student book, we will work with different listening channels and find activities that will motivate and have the students participate in their comprehension and interpretation. We will also use in class:

- Musical auditions
- Radio programs
- Watching the news
- Television series or short films
- Comprehension and interpretation of daily conversations
- Understanding instructions
- Listening to different accents depending on the geographical area

For a successful listening comprehension, a special attention is required not only to the strictly linguistic issues (sounds, words, syntactic structures...), but also to the tone, the pauses and intonation, repetition, the order, and even the gestures and situations necessary for the oral speech to take place. These aspects will also be present in class.
